



Information for Applicants 2021-2022

Candidates to be considered for all MSc Programs (except for the MSc in International Shipping & Finance Program) must submit the following documents:

- Alba's application form through our website: http://www.campusweb.acg.edu/ICS/Admissions_ALBA/
- A certified copy of their Bachelor's degree,
- Official academic transcripts from each undergraduate, graduate or professional school attended,
- Two letters of recommendation (Alba accept recommendation letters, either in Greek or in English language)
- A minimum of 3 years substantial work experience is required for all MBA Programs
- Evidence of fluency in the English language. Candidates are required to hold the Proficiency (Cambridge or Michigan or Michigan State University (MSU)) or take the TOEFL (the required score is 100 or above – ALBA's code 0942) or IELTS (the required score is 6.5 or above), or a bachelor's degree from a university where all courses were taught in English.
- A minimum GMAT score of 550 and above (or a GRE score of 155 and above) will strengthen the application for the MSc program of an applicants' choice. In cases of "weak" academic background and after the faculty evaluation of the file, the Academic Committee reserves the right to conditionally accept an applicant for a Master program, upon bringing a GMAT score of 550 and above (or a GRE score of 155 and above) prior the beginning of the program. (Alba MBA GMAT code 3BM-38-74 and GRE DI code 0942)
- Receipt of the non- refundable application fee's deposit: After the online submission of your application, you will receive via email a unique banking ID & further instructions for the payment of the non-refundable application fee of 60€. The process of issuing your banking ID takes 3-4 working days, right after the online submission of your application. Applicants who will not proceed with the payment of the application fee, they will not receive the final decision for their application from the respective academic program.

Applicants who cannot obtain an official transcript by the time of application may submit a photocopy as a temporary substitute, in order to expedite the evaluation process.

All candidates will be asked to go through a personal interview.

Applications with one or more missing documents will not be processed until these documents are received. Admission to the Program is decided by the Admissions Committee on the basis of the qualifications and the applicant's personality and commitment.

Alba accepts applications all year round & candidates are encouraged to apply as soon as possible. However, applications received after the beginning of the program will not be reviewed for the current intake, but will certainly be reviewed for next year's intake.
