



Women on Top Scholarship in Cooperation with Alba Graduate Business School

To Women on Top (www.womenontop.gr) offers two partial and merit based scholarships for the postgraduate degrees¹ offered by Alba Graduate Business School, The American College of Greece (www.alba.acg.edu) in the academic period 2022/23.

The purpose of this initiative is to support women who are ready to invest in their professional development, with the aim of working creatively in demanding yet promising roles, that they will retain throughout most of their career and ensure their financial independence.

The scholarship is available to interested applicants from WoT's community who aspire to substantially contribute to the prosperity of the businesses that they will work for (or create themselves) and bring positive change in the society around them through their job. There is no age limit or specific professional profile required of the candidates. The scholarship covers 50% of the degree tuition fee.

In order to receive the scholarship, applicants need to both complete the relevant evaluation form by Women on Top and receive a positive evaluation of their academic application submitted to Alba Graduate Business School for the postgraduate degree of interest. To claim one of the two scholarships offered by Women on Top applicants need to:

The scholarship recipients will be selected among the applicants who have successfully gone through the academic evaluation process by a joint Women on Top and Alba Graduate Business School committee based on the following criteria:

- The way they have showcased their motivation, commitment and potential in the Women on Top questionnaire.
- Their academic application submitted to Alba.

The deadline for the scholarship applications is 31/05/2022 and refer to degree programs that will be starting in September and October 2022 or January 2023 depending on the academic program. Up to that date, applicants need to have expressed their interest for the scholarship by following the guidelines outlined previously and have finalized their application for the selected postgraduate degree. Classes take place at Alba's downtown Athens campus.

Women On Top is a non-profit organization aiming for the professional empowerment of women and for equality at work. It was founded in 2012 and since then has created and monitored over 930 mentoring partnerships for the benefit of unemployed women - women who want to change their professional career, establish themselves in male-dominated professions, build their own businesses etc. It has also trained over 1200 unemployed, employed and self-employed women in skills camps offering childcare for the little ones of those who are mothers. Moreover, through the Women on Top in Business initiative, we provide training, consulting and project management services to businesses and organizations wishing to prioritize the equal representation of women at work, by investing in the diversity and inclusivity of their talent pools as well as to the work/life balance of their employees. Last but not least, it has developed a wide communication and content creation platform (surveys, articles, podcasts, events etc), in order to build powerful networks around the goal of gender equality, help promote positive and strong female role models and raise awareness, among the general public as well as decision making bodies, around the obstacles that women face, even in this day and age, in their equal participation in public life.

Note:

All students receiving scholarships on the basis of merit, either in full or in part, are expected to maintain a Cumulative Index (CI) or a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 and above. The CI corresponds to the average grade of all course grades that have been reported, while the GPA corresponds to the average grade of the course grades of a particular term. If both the CI and GPA of a scholarship recipient drops below 3.0, for all courses that have been completed and grades that have been announced through myACG portal, the scholarship will be discontinued until such time as the term GPA or the CI rises to 3.0 and above. In such cases, the student will become personally liable for payment of tuition fees corresponding to the teaching period that follows right after the announcement of the grades of the preceding term, in which both the term GPA and the CI have been reported below 3.0. This rule does not apply to the first and the last teaching period of all Academic Programs.
