Student Tuition fees: **650 Euro**

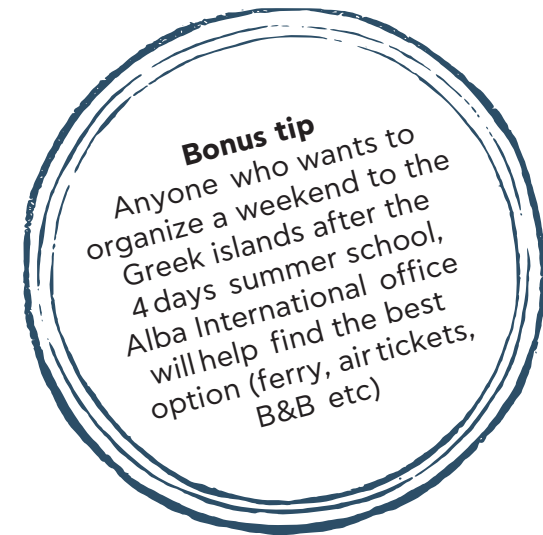
Administration fee for exchange partner schools: **250 Euro**
