- a. Academic performance and
- b. Candidate's overall profile.

Academic Performance

The following table indicates the percentage of tuition waiver you may be entitled to, on the basis of your previous degree(s) Grade Point Average (GPA):

UK	US	Greek AEI	Scholarship (% of Tuition)
70+ first	3.6+	8,01+	20%
66-69 (2:1 high)	3.31-3.59	7,51-8	15%
61-65 (2:1)	3.00-3.30	7,01-7,5	10%

Candidate's Overall Profile

Additional criteria including, but not limited to, work experience, advanced degrees, professional qualifications and interview performance, may increase the total tuition waiver up to 30%

All students receiving a merit scholarship are expected to maintain a CI of at least 3.0. If a scholarship recipient's CI drops below 3.0 at the end of the second period, the scholarship is discontinued until it reverts to 3.0, or above. In that case, the student has the obligation to pay the tuition amount corresponding to that period.
