



Merit-based Scholarships for the ALBA MBA

Merit Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic performance in previous tertiary level studies in addition to other criteria such as, but not limited to, work experience, advanced degrees, professional qualifications and interview performance.

The following table indicates the amount of tuition waiver you may be entitled to:

US GPA	Greek AEI GPA	Scholarship %
3.70+	9+	20%
3.5 - 3.69	8.0 - 8.99	15%
3.30 - 3.49	7.45 - 7.99	10%

All students receiving a merit scholarship are expected to maintain a Career Totals GPA of at least 3.0. If a scholarship recipient's Career Totals GPA drops below 3.0 at the end of the second period, the scholarship is discontinued until it reverts to 3.0, or above. In that case, the student has the obligation to pay the tuition amount corresponding to that period.
