MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Incoming students need to be at graduate level. If the students want to participate at any of the MBA courses, then they need to have at least 3 years of working experience. They also need to have good knowledge of English language, TOEFL min 100 or IELTS min 6,5. DUOLINGO min 125

NOMINATION DEADLINES

Fall Term: April 30th
Winter Term: August 30th
Spring Term: November 30th

SEMESTERS

Programs are taught in 3 month terms (Fall, Winter, Spring). Detailed time schedule is announced when students are accepted in the program. Students may combine courses between programs if they don't overlap in time schedule. Students may collect up to 8 – 10 US credits (20 – 24 ECTS) per term. There is no minimum credit requirement for exchange students.

LANGUAGE OF COURSES

All courses are taught in English.

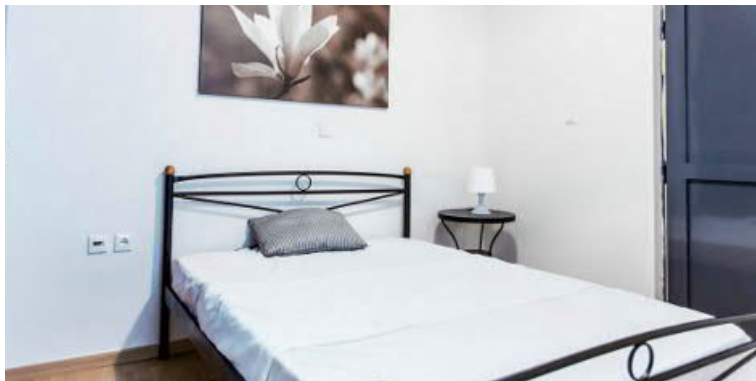
VISA

Non EU students, for visits of more than 3 months, require student visa. A certain procedure needs to be followed with Greek Embassies. We need at least 2 months before arrival to make arrangements.



ACCOMMODATION AND LIVING EXPENSES

For longer visits and according to availability, Alba may provide furnished apartments upon request (approx. 500 Euro/bills included). In that case students may have to share an apartment with other international students.



Monthly living cost for studying in Athens depends on students' life style. A rough estimation of average living cost in Athens is approximately 300-400 Euros per month (excluding accommodation).

Other Accommodation options close to the Campus

The campus is located in the city center and many Airbnb options are available in nearby areas like Ambelokipi, Ilisia, Zografou, Pagrati etc. Please contact the International Office to confirm proximity before booking your apartment.
